Vera Stanković is a visual artist from Serbia, based in Ljubljana, Slovenia. She is an insightful story-teller, her multi-disciplinary work is full of honest reminiscences of the intimate world yet critical of broader social issues. Vera Stanković graduated at the Belgrade Faculty of Electrical Engineering (Computer Studies) and at the Faculty of Fine Arts (Painting) in Belgrade, where she also received her MFA.
